### Honourable Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi inaugurates India's first automobile in-plant railway siding at Suzuki Motor Gujarat

- This initiative is a part of Prime Minister's flagship Gati Shakti programme

**Becharaji, Gujarat, March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024:** Honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated India's first automobile in-plant railway siding at Suzuki Motor Gujarat Private Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Maruti Suzuki India Limited (MSIL) via video conferencing today. As part of Prime Minister's flagship Gati Shakti programme, this in-plant railway siding aims to reduce carbon footprint in logistics, bring down fossil fuel consumption, and reduce road congestion.

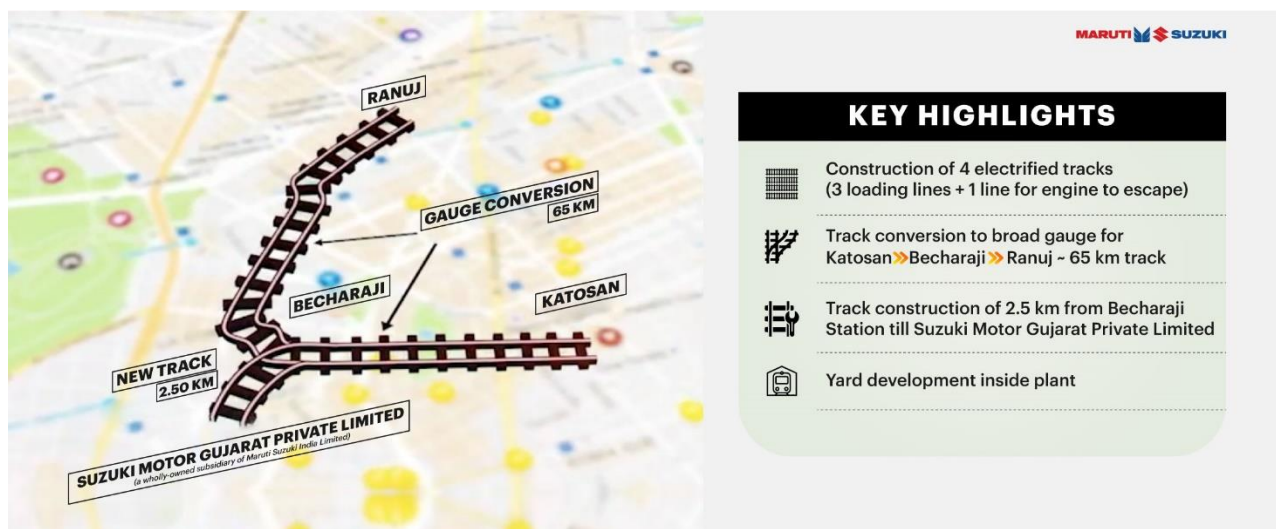
Once fully operational, the Gujarat railway siding facility can dispatch 300,000 cars annually to 15 destinations across India.

#### About the project:

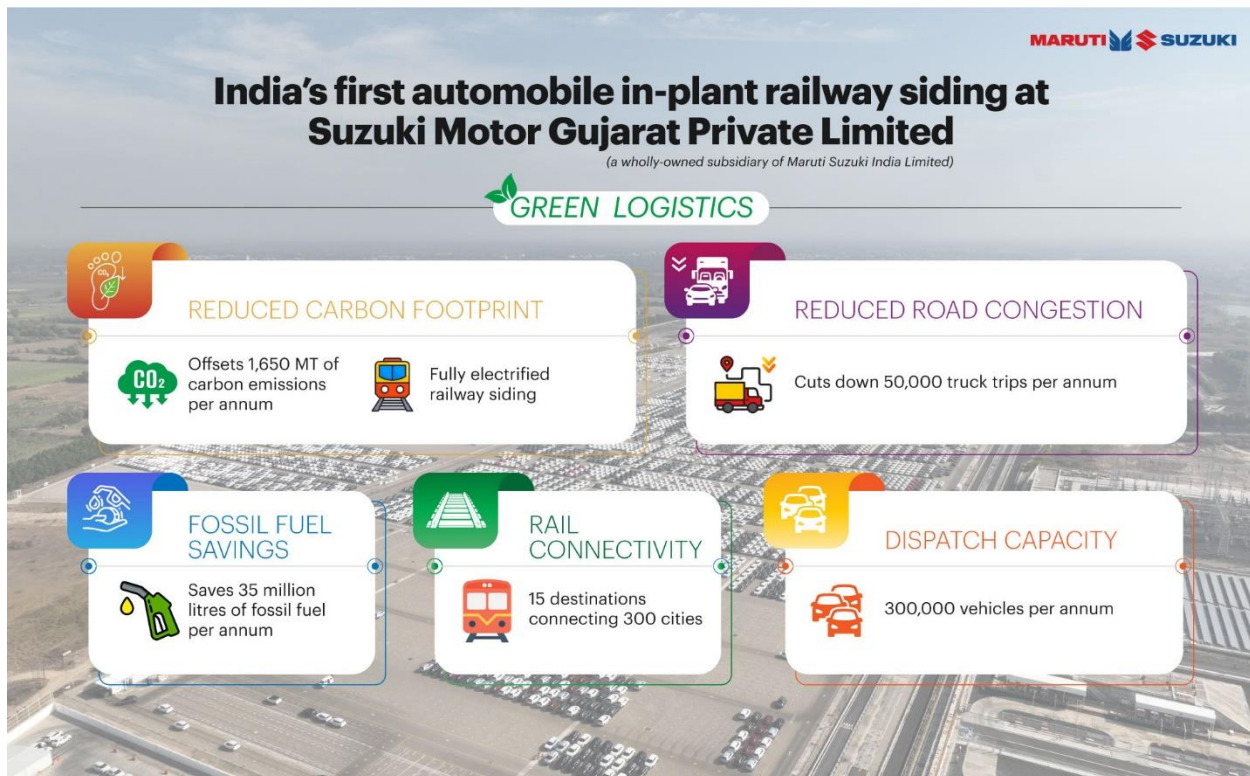
