## Maruti Suzuki's Innovation programs:

These programs are, 1) Incubation, 2) Mobility and Automobile Innovation Lab (MAIL), and 3) Mobility Challenge. So far, Maruti Suzuki has engaged with 54 startups and enabled 27 Proof-of-Concepts.
