Misconception that India subsidises exports, says Prabhu

UNION MINISTER FOR Commerce and Civil Aviation Suresh Prabhu on Saturday sought to dispel the notion of other countries that India subsidises its exports.

He said the government was merely trying to mitigate the adversities of the exporters, which did not amount to subsidising of exports from India, especially in farm products. "It is a misconception that we subsidise our exports. We are fully WTO-compliant and not at all violating regulations," Prabhu said at an event here.

He said the government for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) countries were giving more subsidies to their farmers, particularly in the export of agricultural products. Talking about agriculture exports, he said "it should not be so that when India exports its agriculture products to other countries, which is a major trade item, it is subsidising its exports."

Some WTO member countries are now questioning the success of trade norms, and India has not stepped in the form of the 'most challenging period in the last 70 years' of global trade, he said. —PTI

'Plans to cut emission levels of old power plants by 2022'

STARTING NEXT YEAR, India has planned to bring down emission levels of all old power plants in the national standards by 2022, a top environment ministry official said. Union environment secretary CK Mishra also said "very old" plants in the country might be closed down.

"When it comes to addressing climate change issues, the first thing we need to do is to acknowledge the reality — the fact that the Paris agreement, the nationally determined contributions (NDCs) announced by India, so far, according to me, are already ambitious," he said at an event here. "But, there are development imperatives and India is one of the fastest growing economies, so as growth takes place, emissions levels are bound to rise. The story of India and its narratives is of responsible growth."

He said the focus of the road ahead in the clean energy sector is to run National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) is doing retrofitting works in old plants in a "big way", the secretary said. "It is a time-consuming process, and it will take several months to 18 months," he commented. Mishra said the emission scenario would improve if emission norms for boilers and technology at all plants to minimise emissions are implemented. Thermal and other fossil fuel-based power plants are one of the main causes of air pollution. "Doing it well worth it, as the cost of not doing it is higher," he said.

The secretary said the Bhopal Thermal Power Plant in Delhi remains "closed".

"I would like to mention one case of 'extremely critical power situation' — The Kadappur plant, for example, remains closed. We are monitoring it, and will take the decision of whether it is extremely critical power situation in Delhi. Now, any way, you are shut down, as we have an alternative system being built," he added.

In Bhopal, the 250 MW plant running at 30% capacity, it has a unit of 750 MW on the way, he said.

"By next month, the first unit of 750 MW will fully run along with full capacity gas. It is a much better fuel," he said.

Mishra said, while the Paris agreement has its own modalities, "what about the pre-2020 commitments? The 2015 Paris accord is an agreement between the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) involving all green house gas emissions' mitigation, adaptation, and finance commitments."

The agreement sets out a global action plan to put the world on track to avoid a dangerous climate change by limiting global warming to well below 2°C above pre-industrial levels.
