1. How to use 'Music' feature in Smartplay Dock?

Connect your phone with compatible audio through Bluetooth connection and play via supported media players from phone to stream the audio through vehicle speakers. Also, you may control the connected vehicle entertainment sources i.e. FM, AM, USB, iPod & Aux.

2. How do I connect my co-passenger's phone to play media?

You can connect one Bluetooth device as Audio and another Bluetooth device as Phone. Ensure that the co-passenger's phone is present in the pairing list of Infotainment system Press Menu from Infotainment system -> Select Bluetooth Settings -> Select Pairing-> Select Pairing Audio List and connect the phone to stream music via BT-A mode.

3. How does long press and short press work on FM/AM/USB/iPod/BT-A source for media change on application?

- While in FM/AM media playing screen, user shall:
 - a) Short press the right/left arrow to move to next step in frequency.
 - b) Long press the right/left arrow to seek next/previous station.
- While in USB/iPod/BT-A media playing screen, user can long press right/left arrow to fast forward/rewind and short press right/left for next/previous operation (if supported by device).

4. Which 3rd party music apps are compatible with Smartplay Dock?

Multiple music apps are supported. However, the following apps work best with Android phones:

1. Google Play Music
2. Amazon Music
3. Wynk Music
4. Gaana

For iOS phones, default music player of phone is supported.
